If a detector is over 7 years old, it should be replaced.

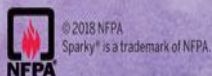

Topside Trail Project Kicks Off, Seeks Donors

The Topside Trail Project is a massive enhancement to health, recreation and quality of life opportunities in our area. It is a comprehensive project aimed at the revitalization of Goodland and consists of 1.6 miles of **new** trail within Steever Park and the Northwest Tech campus. It will provide connectivity to downtown and eventually out into the county. A Dog Park and Welcome Center at the Van Gogh, Splash Pad and Amphitheater at Gulick Park and a natural grassland trail on the Northwest Tech campus are added points of interest. The impact on Sherman County will be substantial.

This project is **NOT** funded with taxpayer dollars. All money will come from grants, donations and some community laborers providing their time and expertise. More information will be forthcoming, but we ask that you consider donating to this project at the Sherman County Match Day event to be held in November.
